Developments

Healthy Lifestyle Project was successfully completed and closed off in 2008, but the drive and initiatives in the remaining projects at both sides in Drenthe and in Mytishchy, gradually were felt decreasing. Members in Demma retired, changed job or took new positions. Demma Foundation encountered a “midlife crisis”

In a meeting held on 1st of April – far from a joke – it was decided to temporarily hold all projects and to seek for a fresh, mutual and confirmed basis for further continuation.

Review

In the 4th quarter of 2008 it was agreed with our colleagues in Russia that a delegation from the Netherlands would visit Mytishchy in January/February 2009 for discussions. A topic list on the viability of all outstanding projects was to be generated and a new Agreement of Collaboration would guarantee any future activities of Demma.
